POLICY H: DETERMINATION OF REGULAR ASSESSMENTS AND SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

1.Use of Terms.

- 1.1. The term "Regular Assessment" refers to the periodic payments from each Owner to the Association and is commonly known as "monthly dues".
- 1.2. The term "Special Assessment" refers to irregular payments due from each Owner to the Association from time to time.

2. <u>Determination of Charges</u>

- 2.1. The amount charged for "Regular Assessments" is based on the size of the Owner's Unit. The size of the Unit has been determined by the Board of Directors to fall into one of three categories: Small Size Units, Medium Size Units, and Large Size Units.
- 2.2. The following are specific Unit size categories:

2.3. When a Regular Assessment is levied, the total assessment is apportioned by percentage based on the unit size. (Note: the total number of assessments paying units in Skiwatch is 38; Unit 239 is the Manager's unit and is non assessment paying. The Unit category percentages are:

Small Size Units: 2.52% Medium Unites: 2.67% Large Units: 2.80%

2.4. When a Special Assessment is levied, the total assessment is apportioned based on 38 Skiwatch Units. Each unit owner will be responsible for an equal amount, one thirty-eight (1/38) of the total assessment.

3. Rational for Category Sizes

3.1. Medium and Large size units own more square footage of Skiwatch property and therefore receive more benefit from the general budget than the Small Units.
